### BIG GAME HUNTING

#### CHUKOTKA (EASTERN) MOOSE

**LOCATION:** Yakutia, Magadan, Kamchatka  
**DATES:** September 15 - November 30  
**GROUP SIZE:** 1 - 3  
**ACCOMMODATIONS:** Tent camps, log cabins.  
**DURATION OF HUNT:** 10-12 hunting days (12-16 days from Moscow)  
**HUNTING METHOD:** Stalking, bugling.

**COMMENTS:** Chukotka moose is among the largest moose subspecies in the world. It populates vast territory of Southern Chukotka, Kamchatka, Northern Magadan and eastern Yakutia. This hunt is conducted in heavy brush and timber and demands walking up to 10 miles each day. In certain areas hunters can hunt along the river banks and move in a motor boat. The smallest trophy should be expected to have a spread of around 150cm (60 in). Occasional trophies can be in the range of 170 cm (70 in). The hunter may spend a few nights away from the base camp. Transportation during the hunt in Kamchatka depending on the season is on the horseback or snowmobile. Temperatures can range from +15 to -15° C (+60 to +5° F). We recommend packing a light sleeping bag, rubber boots and waterproof clothes

**COMMENTS:** European moose is not the largest moose in Russia, however, good trophies, similar to Canada moose can be taken in some areas. The temperature can range from 0 to -20° C. We recommend bringing water proof tall winter boots, warm gloves, warm winter clothes in November and December. Hunting bear can be offered only during bugling season, which ends around October 5 and requires at least three additional days.

Bears, wolves foxes and lynx can also be encountered. The temperature can range from +15 to -20° C. We recommend bringing water proof tall winter boots, warm gloves, warm winter clothes in November and December. Bears can be taken only early in season before hibernation

**COMMENTS:** Magadan region has very high concentration of sheep, found at elevations of 300 to 1000 m. (1000 - 3000 ft.). On a good day hunter can spot up to 30 rams. Magadan region is a home to 3 subspecies of snow sheep: Yakutsk in the North, Okhotsk in the South and Kolyma in the central parts of the region. The weather, especially at the end of September can get harsh. It is important to bring warm, waterproof clothes and waterproof mountain boots.

**COMMENTS:** Hunt starts from Okhotsk with approximately 1.5 hr helicopter flight. Hunt takes place at elevations of up to 1800 m. (6000 ft.). Tent camp is located very close to the hunting grounds. The average trophy size is 36 in. The record trophy taken in this area was 41 in. The weather, especially at the end of September can get rainy. The temperature range is 50/77° F (+10/+25° C) during daytime to 41° F (+5°C) at night. Hunters must bring warm, light, waterproof clothes, waterproof mountain boots and sleeping bag.

**COMMENTS:** Koryak snow sheep is the rarest and the largest subspecies of snow sheep. Hunt takes place at elevations of up to 2000 m. (6600 ft.). The hunt is conducted on foot. Because of difficult terrain with rocks and heavy underbrush, it can be physically demanding. Kamchatka sheep is nearly as large as Koryak. It has a few subtle differences, which is enough for some biologist to consider it a different subspecies. Weather in Northern Kamchatka, especially at the end of September can get harsh. Hunters must bring warm, waterproof clothes, waterproof mountain boots and sleeping bag.

## MARCO POLO OR HUME ARGALI SHEEP

**HUNTING METHOD:** Stalking  
**COST OF HUNT:** Includes meeting at the airport, ground transfers, interpreter, accommodations, 3 meals per day, guides, field trophy preparation veterinary certificate, CITES permit, gun permit, 1 ram.

**COMMENTS:** Kyrgyzstan argali is in average smaller than Tajikistan. However, trophies in excess of 50 inches and up to 60 are not unusual. Hunting takes place at altitudes of 3,000 - 4,000 meters (9,500 - 12,500 ft.) and requires good physical endurance. Hunters should expect to spend up to 6-8 hours per day riding horses. A car ride from Bishkek to the hunting area takes about 12 hours, but it is possible to charter a helicopter instead for an additional cost. Daytime temperature is around +10C (+50F) in the fall and -20C (-4F) in the winter, at night it can drop to -40C (-40F). Hunters are required to bring sleeping bags, sunglasses and a sunscreen. Shots are expected within 250-400 yards range, therefore flat shooting rifle with good optics and a range finder are necessary.

**COMMENTS:** Mid-Asian ibex is the largest in the world. It can be found in several Central Asian republics; however, Kyrgyzstan has much higher number of the animals and the best trophies. The hunt takes place on altitudes 3500-4500 meters (11000-14000 ft.). Horses are extensively used for transportation during the hunt. Accommodations are in yurts, or cabins. The chance of getting a trophy over 115 cm (46 in) is nearly 70%. Many trophies are in excess of 50 inches.

**COMMENTS:** The hunt is conducted in a mountainous terrain at approximately 9000 ft. Good physical condition is required. Horses are frequently used on this hunt. Daily travel is up to 10 miles. We recommend wearing warm, silent clothes and water proof leather boots. Shooting distance is about 200-450 yards. Combined maral and ibex hunts require at least 10 hunting days. We recommend adding 2-3 days for each additional trophy, such as bear or moose.

**COMMENTS:** Khakassia and Altai are mountainous parts of Southern Siberia, located close to the borders with Mongolia and Kazakhstan. This remote and rarely hunted land offers wide range of game and exciting hunting opportunities. The hunt is conducted by stalking. The best time is the bugling season, from August 25 to September 20. The weather is usually mild. Hunters often have a possibility to take more than one trophy. Maral stag, musk deer, and bear can be hunted with additional 4 days. Wolves and lynx can be taken as trophies of opportunity.

**COMMENTS:** This high end hunt is offered on a private land totaling 9000 hectares (22000 acres). The lodge is located 190km from the city of Samara. Hunters stay in private rooms and enjoy traditional Russian cuisine. The best time to get trophy roe is October 15-November 25.

**COMMENTS:** Tur is a unique animal found only in the Caucasus mountains. All three subspecies can be hunted in Russia, and only Dagestan tur in Azerbaijan. Shooting over a distances of 200-300 meters is common. Hunting camps are located at altitude of up to 2500 meters (8000 ft.), and approximately 4-6 hours traveling from the airport. Transportation to the spike camps from the base camps is done either on horseback, or on foot. This is one of the most difficult mountain hunts in the world. The hunt takes place at an altitude of about 2800 to 3500 meters (9000-11500 ft.) and is physically demanding due to very steep, rocky and precipitous slopes. Hunting Western tur in Krasnodar region of Russia or in Abkhazia takes place at about 8000-9000 ft making it considerably easier than in other regions. Hunter should bring sleeping bag, sun glasses, sun screen, rain gear, rangefinder and binoculars.

**COMMENTS:** Siberian bear hunts take place in rugged and heavily forested terrain, where getting in range of the bear offers a greater challenge. The best chance to spot and stalk a bear is in the foothills of the mountains, or along the lake shore, where the forest is less dense. Getting from the base camp to the foothills and back in the Altai region will require an additional two days of travel by horseback. Another option, baiting, is frequently used when hunting takes place in the dense forest. The average trophy is similar in size to a North American grizzly. The weather is usually cool, especially in spring, when the temperature can drop into subfreezing range. Bring your sleeping bag and warm clothing.

**COMMENTS:** These are some of the best hunts in the European part of Russia. The bear population during the past 20 years has been very stable. The usual trophy size is about 7 ft., although 8 - 8.5 ft. bears have been taken by our clients every year. The record bear taken in the Pskov region in 1999 had a skull measured in excess of 27 inches (69 cm) The success rate is about 90%. Some hunters take more than one bear. The weather is usually mild and can be rainy. Be prepared to deal with mosquitoes if you are hunting early in the season. Small game hunting and fishing is offered at no additional cost

**COMMENTS:** The Magadan region is truly unspoiled wilderness. Located on the mainland across the sea from the Kamchatka Peninsula it is a huge landmass with a small population, which guarantees very little hunting pressure. In the Spring bears concentrate along the shoreline, looking for seafood. During the Fall hunting season bears are either feeding on salmon in the many rivers and creeks, or on wild berries in the surrounding tundra. Fall hunt is offered only as a boat drift hunt with a helicopter drop-off. The bears are about the same size as the coastal bears of Kamchatka Peninsula, or Alaska. The average size of the bears trophy is around 8.5 ft. Often a hunter can see up to 30 bears during the trip. In some areas along the sea of Okhotsk shore during the spring hunt it is possible to observe 20-30 and more bears at once from a single location. The success rate is essentially 100%. Many hunters choose to take 2 bears. Bird hunting and fishing are available during the fall at no additional cost. Warm clothes are essential for May and September hunts, when temperature can be in the subfreezing range.

The bear found on the island is a brown bear variety known as Amur brown bear. Local bears feed primarily on salmon, making them just about as large as Kamchatka bears. One of the distinct features of Sakhalin bear is elongated skull, which can measure larger than Kamchatka bear skull. Sakhalin island is a home to about 4000 bears. Sakhalin brown bears feed primarily on salmon and grow to be as large as Kamchatka bears. Spring hunt takes place while the snow is still present on the ground, which aids in locating best trophies. Pacific taimen and salmon fishing is spectacular and can be enjoyed at no additional cost. Sakhalin climate is relatively mild. Hunting pressure is very low and quota is usually filled to about 50-80% for a total of less than 150 animals a year. **COMMENTS:** Kanin peninsula is located above the Arctic Circle between White and Barents seas. This sparsely populated area is a breeding ground to large number of waterfowl birds. The most common trophies include White-Fronted, Graylag, Brent goose, and Bean goose, Green-winged Teal, Northern Pintail, Eurasian Widgeon, Greater Scaup, Tufted Pochard, Black Scoter, White-winged Scoter, Long-tailed duck, Red-breasted merganser and others. Taimyr peninsula is one of the Northernmost parts of Russia. It is a breeding grounds to hundreds of thousands of game birds. The large number of geese allows hunters to take 10 and more birds per day. Both areas support large number of different shorebirds. The weather can be unpredictable. Hunters should bring warm, waterproof camouflage clothes (white in the spring and brown in the fall) and rubber boots.

Grayling is 0.5-1 kg (1-2 lbs.) Fishing is very intense, catch and release, with limited number of fish in possession.
